This May saw the all-out election of the Parish Council. The resulting makeup of the Parish Council is as follows (the change since the inaugural 2017 election shown in brackets):

Labour 19 (+4)

Conservatives 3 (-1)

Liberal Democrat's 1 (-3)

We welcome the newly elected Councillors and look forward to working together constructively and with the single aim of continuing to provide value for money and improving the Parish for all residents.

The Parish Council will seek to implement its mandate of greater investment in local service such as street cleaning, grass cutting and bin emptying.

Whilst adding value to the Parish by continuing to protect green space, promoting biodiversity, supporting libraries and investing in community centres, we will also embark on our flagship long term projects of renewing play equipment, regenerating the formal parks of Town Gardens and Queens Park and improving the leisure offering.

We are excited at the prospect of developing a 5 mile nature corridor from Shaftesbury Lake to the canal at Kingshill Road over the next four years. We aim to include in the project the creation of a Parish Country Park and wild-flower meadows. We look forward to working in partnership with the Borough Council, Wiltshire Wildlife Trust, Parishioners and other stakeholders who wish to contribute to this ambitious and vital project.

We look forward to working with Parishioners to ensure our Parish flourishes and continues to improve and enhance the area for all.
