

Swindon Gas Pipe Upgrade

I want to let you know about our upcoming gas pipe upgrade work in Swindon. This will make sure that we keep the gas flowing to heat homes and power businesses in the area, so you and your family are safe and warm for generations to come.

We will start our work on 17 February on Kingshill Road and barring any engineering difficulties, we expect to be finished by 21 February.

To keep the local community, road users and our colleagues safe, the inbound lane along Wootton Bassett Road will be closed from Redpost Drive to its junction of Kingshill Road whilst we work.

We know our work can be disruptive, so we have worked closely with Swindon Borough Council to keep this to a minimum.

This essential gas pipe investment work is part of our multi-million-pound 30 year gas pipe investment programme across the south west of England and Wales. Old metal gas pipes within 30 metres of buildings are being upgraded to new, long lasting plastic ones. We are spending £1.4 million on this programme every week to keep the gas flowing and make sure your gas network is fit for the future.
