

Swindon Borough Council (Waiting and Loading Restrictions and Parking Places Consolidation) Order 2017 (Variation No 4) Order 2020

STATEMENT OF REASONS

This Order seeks to remove 15 metres of double yellow lines (no waiting at any time), and install a No Stopping Except buses, (Bus Stop Clearway).

This proposal is to formalise arrangements at the Gladstone Street east-bound bus stop which forms part of a wider project to introduce a Quality Bus Corridor linking Tadpole Garden Village with Swindon town centre. The Gladstone Street east-bound bus stop was created following a change in the route of the bus service operating between Swindon town centre and Tadpole Garden Village to bypass Manchester Road and County Road.

Therefore Swindon Borough Council proposes to revoke No Waiting at any time Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) and replace with a Bus Stop Clearway.

The reasons for making this order are as follow;

- a. For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road and or any other road or preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising; or
- b. For facilitating the passage on the road, or any other road, of any class of traffic (including pedestrians), or
- c. For preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs, or
- d. to improve the environment for local residents

This request has been delivered in conjunction with local Ward Councillors. Consultation has been carried out with emergency services and other relevant stakeholders.
