

# PUBLIC NOTICE

**SWINDON BOROUGH COUNCIL  
(WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS AND PARKING PLACES  
CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2017)  
EXPERIMENTAL ORDER (NO. 3) 2020**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 29 July 2020 Swindon Borough Council made an Experimental Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to be operative from the 10 August 2020 for the duration of 18 months.

**Crombey Street outside No's 24 - 26**

To revoke the Residents Parking Mon-Sat 8am-10pm Permit Holders Zone A bay to be replaced with 'no waiting at any time' restriction.

The Experimental Order is introduced to allow the Council to implement the restrictions with immediate effect.

Any person wishing to make representations whether to object to or support the Order before it is made permanent must do so by completing the consultation form which can be found at [www.swindon.gov.uk/trafficregulationorders](http://www.swindon.gov.uk/trafficregulationorders) under 'experimental traffic regulation orders' reference (H&T/TRO/Crombey Street) by no later than 10 February 2021. Any objection or representation received will form part of a public record which may be made publicly available.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirements of that Act or of any instrument made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 29 July 2020 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
